

Lower Intermediate Summer Reading Assignment

Dear Parents:

Summer reading is an integral part of your child's education. Therefore, each student is required to read **two** books during the summer.

The following book must be read by each student, and a book report must be written and turned in to the language arts class in the fall:

Avi- Poppy

Each student must also choose **one** book from the list below and complete a book report. You may choose one of the following formats for your report. The book report will be submitted to the teacher on September 11th.

- Create a book jacket, complete with illustrations. **Or**
- Write a biography of the main character, using information from the book. **Or**
- Create a mural that shows key incidents in the story.

Fitzhugh, Louise- *Harriet the Spy*

Smith, Robert K.- *Chocolate Fever*

Wilder, Laura Ingalls- *Little House on the Prairie*

In addition to the summer reading, each student should keep a written journal throughout the summer. It may include explanations of what they did during the days or weeks, their own short stories, poems, dreams, wishes, etc. The entries must be complete sentences, and there should be at least **three** entries per week for each week of summer vacation, for a total of at least **30** entries. This, too, will be submitted to the teacher during the first week of school in the fall.

Please discuss and share your child's reading. If your child is experiencing difficulty with the summer reading, please read with him or her. This will give you an opportunity to spend time with your child. If you would like suggestions for additional reading, do not hesitate to ask for help at your library.
