## 2018 - Upper Primary (3<sup>rd</sup> Grade) Summer Reading Book Report Project

This project will count as your first Language Arts test grade. Please follow all of the directions below to receive a full score. All projects are due on the <u>first day of school</u>. Use the rubric on the back as a guideline when doing your project.

- 1. Choose a chapter book from Mrs. Scheule's list.
- 2. Read the entire book.
- 3. Create a book jacket for the book that you read. This must include a front cover for your book (different from the real cover) and a summary of your book on the back cover. You may use construction paper or computer paper for your front/back covers. You can either handwrite or type your back cover summary. Your summary must be 8- 10 sentences. You will be graded on neatness, spelling, grammar, and punctuation.
- 4. Create an AR test for someone who will be taking a test on this book in the future. You will need to come up with 10 questions about your book. You may type or handwrite them. Each question will need 3 answer choices. One of those answer choices will be the correct answer (you will have to circle the correct answer). For example:
  - Q: Where does Harry potter attend school?
    - a. The Royal Academy of Magicians
    - b. Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry
    - c. Wizard's Boarding School for Boys
- 5. Please put your name at the top of the "test questions" and staple that paper **<u>behind</u>** your book covers.
- 6. Finally, you will need to write your opinion (typed or handwritten, on a separate piece of paper, also stapled <u>behind</u> your book covers). In at least 5 sentences, what was your opinion of the book? Would you recommend it to a friend? Why or why not? Use examples from the story to support your reasoning.
